It is impossible to completely eliminate the risks of all germs, including COVID-19, however if we learn and diligently practice coordinated interventions, we can significantly reduce the risk of contracting and spreading COVID-19, as well as other unwanted germs and viruses. These interventions include, but are not limited to:

- Proper & Frequent Handwashing: Please teach and reinforce this practice at home before school starts
- Hands off your Face: Teach, practice & remind your child throughout the day so this becomes a habit
- Stay at Home when Sick: If your child has fever or any COVID-19 symptoms, stay at home until resolved and consult your doctor for further guidance.
- Daily temperature scans and screening
- Limiting Contact: Only students and essential staff allowed on campus
- Cohorts: Students remain in specific grade level groups in their class
- Social Distancing: Upon arrival, throughout the day, & dismissal
- Foot Traffic Directions on Campus
- Daily Sanitizing of Classrooms and sanitizing of high touch areas/items throughout the day.
- Masks/Face Coverings: Masks on upon arrival, dismissal, and when deemed necessary
